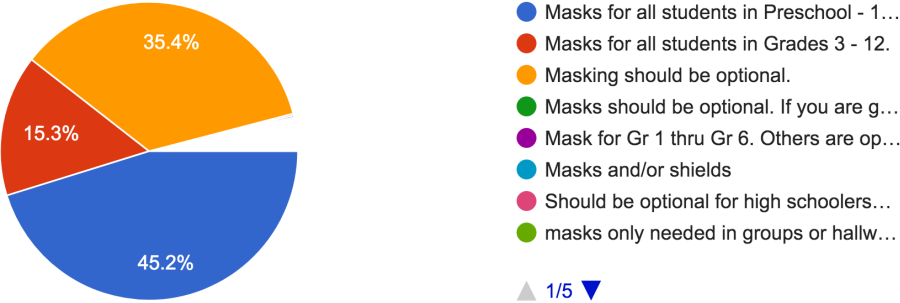

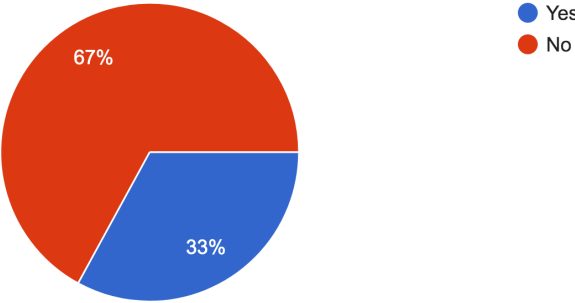
As far as students wearing masks at school is concerned, please select the option that you believe is best for your child while at school?

960 responses



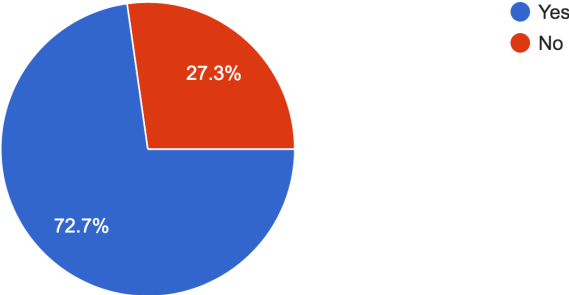
Would you be in favor of establishing a threshold of 7% of the students being positive in a school before requiring masks?

921 responses



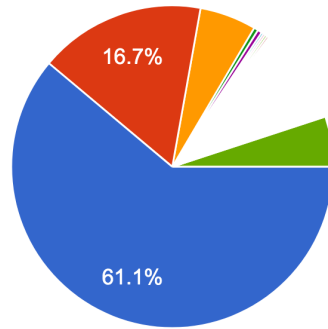
If the District sponsored a vaccination clinic for students age 12 and up at one of the schools prior to school beginning, would you sign your child up to be vaccinated?
